10-5-12 From Tracey:

Hello! I know the cost of renting pool space will vary across the country but will you let me know what you are paying to rent a pool (fee per month, per lane, per person)? Would you also include the area of the country you are working in?

From Terri:

In Austin, Texas fees are varied:

30% of the Physical Therapist's (PT) fee at a city pool

\$4 per person at an indoor pool

40% of the PT's fee at a fitness center pool

From Fran:

In northern California, I pay 20% of gross for exclusive use of an indoor heated hotel pool. Others have charged me up to 30%.

From Doug:

Where I work in Portland Oregon, the Jewish Community Center charges my clientele \$70/hr for Aquatic Therapy, takes 35% and I receive 65%.

10-6 From Anne:

I rent a pool for a 1 hour private session for \$20/hour. I also rent a whole pool for courses for \$40/hour, usually 4 hours per day for \$160. This is in Chicago Illinois.

From Mayne:

The city of Seattle allows our aquatic Physical Therapy program from the VA hospital here to use some space in one of their indoor pools during the adult swim time and charges us \$2.92 each per patient.
